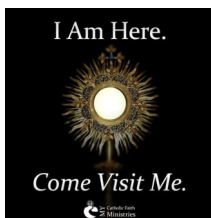

HOMELESS MINISTRY

Thank you to all of the wonderful people who donated food, water and clothing to the Homeless Ministry in 2020. You are truly doing God's work in feeding the homeless.

This coming weekend (July 3, 2021) we are asking for donations of pasta dinners.

This coming **Saturday – July 3, 2021**, we are looking for donation of PASTA dinners (preferably large trays) to make into individual meals. The trays should be pasta, ground meat and tomato sauce topping. They should be made in a disposable container and covered only with aluminum foil.

The suggested recipe is as follows:

A. Pasta with meatballs:

- 2 packages of pasta; (not spaghetti or linguine)
- 2 – 24 oz jars spaghetti sauce;
- 4 meatballs per person (beef, chicken or turkey).

B. Pasta with meat sauce:

- 2 pounds ground beef, chicken or turkey;
- 2 – 24 oz jars spaghetti sauce.
- 2 packages of pasta; (not spaghetti or linguine)

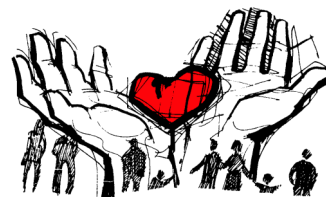
Serve in a disposable aluminum pan. (preferably hot off the stove)

We also are in great need of clothes for men, women and children as well as cases of 1/2 liter bottles of water. Sandwiches are welcome too!! Sandwiches need to be individually wrapped in a sandwich size Ziplock plastic bag for sanitary reasons. For three (3) loaves of prepared sandwiches and 1- case of 24 ½ liter bottles we will award a maximum of 3 community hours with a maximum of 4 loaves of prepared sandwiches and 2 – 24 bottle cases of water for no additional community hours.

Community hours will only be awarded for one type of donation and only for a single donation regardless of how many items are donated.

MINISTERIO DE LOS DESAMPARADOS

Gracias a todas las maravillosas personas que donaron alimentos, agua y ropa al Ministerio de Personas sin Hogar. Ustedes realmente están haciendo la obra de Dios en la alimentación de las personas sin hogar. Este próximo fin de semana (3 de julio de 2021) estamos pidiendo donaciones de cenas de pasta. Este próximo sábado – 3 de julio de 2021, estamos buscando la donación de cenas de PASTA (preferiblemente bandejas grandes) para convertir en comidas individuales. Las bandejas deben ser pasta, carne molida y cobertura de salsa de tomate. Deben hacerse en un recipiente desechable y cubrirse solo con papel de aluminio.

La receta sugerida es la siguiente: Pasta con albóndigas: - 2 paquetes de pasta; (no espaguetis o linguini) - 2 – 24 oz tarros de salsa de espagueti; - 4 albóndigas por persona (ternera, pollo o pavo). B. Pasta con salsa de carne: - 2 libras de carne molida de res, pollo o pavo; - 2 – 24 oz jarros de salsa de espagueti. - 2 paquetes de pasta; (no espaguetis ni linguine))

También estamos en gran necesidad de ropa para hombres, mujeres y niños, así como cajas de botellas de 1/2 litro de agua. Sándwiches son bienvenidos también!! Los sándwiches deben estar envueltos individualmente en una bolsa de plástico Ziplock del tamaño de un sándwich por razones sanitarias. Para tres (3) panes de sándwiches preparados y 1- caja de 24 botellas de 1/2 litro, otorgaremos un máximo de 3 horas comunitarias con un máximo de 4 panes de sándwiches preparados y 2 a 24 cajas de botellas de agua sin horas comunitarias adicionales.

Las horas comunitarias solo se otorgarán para un tipo de donación y solo para una sola donación, independientemente de cómo se donen los artículos.

SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION AT ST. JOHN NEUMANN

BAPTISMS are held on the Second and Fourth Saturday of the month in English and on the Third Saturday of the month in Spanish at 11:00 a.m. Baptismal Preparation classes are held on the First Saturday of the month at 10:00 a.m. in English. You must be a registered parishioner or live within the Parish boundaries. Please call Parish to schedule a Baptism.

COMMUNION AND CONFIRMATION require 2 years of Religious Education preparation in order to receive the Sacrament. Please call the Religious Education Office to register

HOLY MATRIMONY: All couples planning to get married must attend the Marriage Preparation meeting on the Second Tuesday of every month at 7:30 p.m. in Room 100. After you attend the meeting you should schedule to meet with a priest at least 6 to 8 months before the wedding. You must be a registered parishioner or live within the parish boundaries. A date cannot be set until all requirements are met.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK: Anyone who is ill, anticipating surgery, or undergoing medical testing is encouraged to receive the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. Please call the parish office to make an appointment with one of our priests.

COMMUNION TO THE SICK: If you are homebound for any reason and would like to receive communion, please call the parish office so we can arrange for a minister to come to you.
